1. Major changes to the school dress code must be discussed and agreed with the school community before being presented to the Board of Trustees for their consideration.
2. Changes must be made with the minuted agreement of the Board of Trustees.
3. The school will ensure that high expectations for presentation and uniform are maintained.
4. Unless there is a note of explanation, any student wearing non-regulation items of clothing will be asked to immediately remove the item. If the item is not removed, any staff member has the discretion to confiscate the clothing which must be collected at the end of the day.

5. The school will provide loan uniform items for students who do not have the appropriate clothing - these items **MUST** be returned at the end of the school day.
6. If students repeatedly come to school wearing non-regulation uniform and are unwilling to wear loan items, they will be sent home to change.
7. In situations of hardship and other special circumstances the school may provide uniform items for students.
8. All students must wear a change of clothing for Physical Education classes to promote cleanliness.
9. Junior students are expected to wear school PE uniform during Physical Education classes.
10. The school will provide clean PE uniform for students who do not bring their own PE gear. Students must wear the uniform provided and may not exercise in regular uniform.
11. Students are expected to wear covered shoes in the Hard materials classroom and Kitchen.
12. In the first instance, House Group Teachers should be made aware of uniform issues and liaise with whānau to address the matter. If not resolved, Deans will follow up and then a member of the Senior Leadership team.
13. School uniform should be regularly cleaned and in good state. House Group Teachers are expected to talk to students who's uniform is not clean or has fallen into disrepair. If necessary they should communicate with whānau to rectify the matter.
14. **GIRLS STOCKINGS / SOCKS**
 - Girls may wear either black calf-length socks or black opaque stockings
 - Black stockings must be worn for formal/Number One attire
15. **BOYS SOCKS**
 - School knee-length socks or plain black calf length socks
 - Plain black socks (not anklet socks) to be worn under long pants
16. **JACKETS** - All students **MUST** have a jacket. Please choose from:
 - Black puffer jackets
 - Plain black jackets
17. **SHIRTS**
 - Junior boys wear a grey shirt.
 - Junior girls wear white blouses.
 - Senior boys wear plain white business shirts with long sleeves (winter) or short sleeves (summer).
 - Senior girls wear plain white blouses that have long or short sleeves.
18. **SKIRTS**
 - Plain Black Skirts to be worn by Year 12 and 13 girls only
 - Both tartan and black skirts must finish on or below the knee
19. **JERSEYS/CARDIGANS/SWEATSHIRTS**
 - Must be black and school monogrammed (jersey, cardigan or sweatshirt)

20. PANTS

- Shorts and trousers must be black.
- Long black trousers must be 'dress pants' and may be worn by all school members.
- Jeans, Chinos, overly tapered legs and elasticized cuffs are not permitted.

21. FOOTWEAR

- Black leather lace-up shoes or slip on shoes.
- Girls black shoes with a strap and buckle are permitted.
- Black or Brown Roman sandals.
- Black ballet-slipper type shoes are only to be worn by Year 13 students.
- Shoes must be in good repair.

22. HATS

- Black school beanie (available from the school uniform shop)
- Plain black cap (available from the school uniform shop)
- Plain black bucket hat
- Hats are not to be worn inside

23. SCARF

- Plain black

24. NUMBER ONE UNIFORM MUST INCLUDE:

- School tie (boys)
- White blouse or shirt with white or neutral coloured undergarments
- School Blazer (on loan to students for specific events only)

25. FACIAL HAIR

- All students should be clean shaven.

26. HAIRCUTS

- Hair must be a natural colour and neatly groomed.

27. MUFTI UNIFORM

- Year 13s are permitted to wear mufti uniform on Fridays during term time.
- Yr 13 mufti must be clean and tidy and appropriate to wear at school.
- Clothing featuring alcohol and tobacco advertising plus other offensive messages or language is not acceptable.
- Quality sleeveless tops are acceptable but not singlets.
- Hoodies, sweatpants and slippers are not acceptable.
- Jewellery and make-up should be tasteful and not excessive.
- When there is a dispute over the appropriateness of Year 13 dress, the Year 13 Dean will make the final decision in consultation with the Senior Leadership Team if necessary.
